Examination Outline

The Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry has jurisdiction over (1) the materials industry, (2) the industrial machinery manufacturing industry, and (3) the electrical, electronics and information related industries. In these manufacturing fields, we have been accepting Non-Japanese with “Category 1 Specified Technical Skills”. It is required that the applicant has “skills that require a considerable degree of knowledge or experience”. To confirm the level of such skills, the “Examination Evaluating Category 1 Specified Technical Skills for Manufacturing Sectors” will be held in the Philippines on the following schedule.

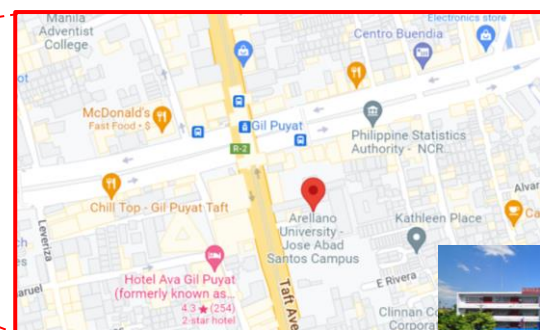
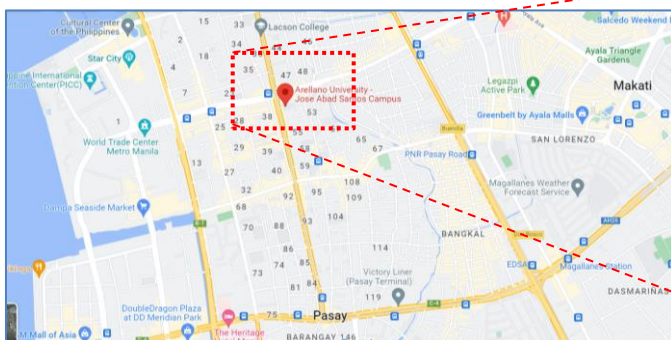

2. Fill in and submit the application form

Please fill in each item on the application form and submit it.

3. Payment of examination fee

Please pay the examination fee to PDMA Secretariat through **GCash** according to the instructions provided at the time of application.

***Please make the payment within 3 days after your application is completed.**

4. Sending email to inform payment

● Please send us a confirmation email that you have paid the examination fee after your payment. Please include the following information in the email:

1. Name of examinee
2. Examination ID number
3. Examination category you applied
4. Date of payment
5. Name of payer (if it is different from 1.)

5. Receipt of application completion email

Once payment has been confirmed, you will receive a confirmation e-mail that your application for the examination is completed. You can also check it from My Page.

*It takes a few days to a week for your payment to be reflected in the system. If you do not receive a confirmation email after one week from the date of payment, please contact us.

6. Download of Examination Voucher

One week before the exam, you will be able to download the exam voucher from My Page. Please read the instructions on My Page carefully and prepare for the exam.

7. The day of examination

- Please arrive early to avoid being late for the exam
- Please print out the exam voucher and bring it to the venue. Also, do not forget to bring the items listed in the exam voucher
- Please wear a mask to prevent coronavirus infection.

Notes on application and examination

- Please note that if an applicant cancels the exam after the application procedure is completed, the examination fee will not be refunded. Also, the examination fee will not be refunded even if the applicant does not take the exam due to inadequate documents such as identification.
- If the exam is postponed or cancelled due to behavioral restrictions caused by the spread of the COVID-19, the examination fee will be refunded.
- Please note that you may not register for more than one exam. If there are multiple registration, the registration will be cancelled.
- For detailed information on the day of exam, please refer the "Examination voucher" which can be downloaded one week before the exam.
- Even if you pass the exam, it is not guaranteed that you will be granted "Specified Technical Skills" status of residence. Even if an application for issuance of a certificate of eligibility or an application for change of status of residence is made to a person who passed the exam, it does not mean that the person can receive a certificate of eligibility or permission for change of status of residence.
- Even if you receive a certificate of eligibility, your visa application will be reviewed separately by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and you will not necessarily be issued a visa.
